- Windows 11 talk:
- This is not the same kind of migration effort as it was from Windows 8 or Windows 7 to Windows 10 — it is much easier and more of a feature update (Windows 10 to Windows 10 update) - Well done Microsoft!
  - Application compatibility vs Windows 10 non issue
  - Deployment Update process non issue (just like another Windows Feature Update
  - Group Policies / Security non-issue (minimal impact)
  - Technical differences / issues Non issue (minimal Impact) With very slight changes In Window Autopilot process

The primary changes are to the user Interface (UI) for both end users and for administrators , Full <u>blog post here</u>

- I have been using Windows 11 for a while now, and one of my favorite features is the multiple desktops feature. It lets me focus and it is like having multiple machines available at any time. Pretty cool! - Check <u>blog post</u> for details.
