Modern EUC Infobits: February 2021 – News you can Use!

There is so much change in the End User Computing space that many of us need help and guidance navigate the Workforce Transformation Journey. The change is not only about Windows 10 or Modern Provisioning but about the entire End User Computing services stack.

This newsletter contains a few items of interest that have caught my eye in the <u>Modern EUC</u> and Workforce Transformation space in the last month or so. This month's highlighted items:

- The FIRST big news that caught my eye since the last newsletter is the Microsoft announcement that the April patch release of Windows 10 will remove Microsoft Edge Legacy out of the operating system. The only supported Microsoft Internet browser will be The New Microsoft Edge (Chromium-based) You can read full article at: <u>RIP</u> <u>Microsoft Edge Legacy</u>
- The SECOND announcement made by Microsoft, this month is that the next version of Windows 10 Enterprise LTSC will be released int the second half of this calendar year (2H21) and will carry a 5-year support lifecycle, instead of the 10year lifecycle supported with previous version. - The THIRD announcement came on February 17, 2020, relates the release of Windows 10 21H1 feature update to Windows Insiders Beta channel and the fact that it confirmed that this feature update will be delivered as an enablement package, allowing Windows 10 2004 and 20H2 users to install the feature update very quickly. <u>Announcement here</u>
- Two additional articles describing a couple of upcoming products (hopefully more info after the soon to come virtual <u>Microsoft Ignite 2021</u>) in the Microsoft lineup that provide options in helping organizations with their client management complexity:
 - Windows 10X All Stars are aligning -
 - Microsoft Cloud PC coming soon
- Over the past year or so, many organizations have focused on addressing the challenges of managing Windows 10 devices for remote workers. Organizations that have already moved their Windows devices management to into MDM tools are now looking to bring other OS platforms like into existing tools and take advantage of a holistic, single pane view of the end-user computing environment. - Microsoft Stream is changing! Launched in 2016, Microsoft Stream is a web app for creating, editing, managing, and discovering videos and playback videos. It was loosely connected to other Microsoft 365 apps and service, and videos were stored separately from it. In September 22, 2020, Microsoft published a blog post titled New Vision for Microsoft Stream. The Microsoft Stream (Classic) is changing and *the new Microsoft Stream* has made video files another document type in the Office suite. Check out the <u>blog post here</u>
